I/We am/are aware that I/we can fully or partly revoke the declaration on the exemption from the duty of non-disclosure at any time, effective for the future. This revocation will mean that the revoked personal data cannot continue to be processed for the relevant purpose, insofar as my/our consent is the only legal basis for the processing³.

I/We am/are also aware that I/we have a right to access information on the processed data and the results of examinations.

Information on exemption from the duty of non-disclosure

While exemption from the duty of non-disclosure can improve the consultation and make it more effective, it is not a pre-requisite for this. Consultations are also possible without exemption from the duty of non-disclosure.

The exemption enables information to be exchanged between psychology, medical and education specialists. Its aim is to ensure optimum diagnostics, consulting, aid and support.

The exemption from the duty of non-disclosure covers all information and personal data relevant to the consultation and diagnostics (initial contact meetings, information on history, results of diagnostic tests and observations etc.). This expressly also covers data particularly worthy of protection, e.g. state of health, ethnic origin, religion and sexual orientation, as per Article 9 of the General Data Protection Regulation), insofar as it is relevant to the consultation.

Psychologists, doctors, social workers and public servants are all bound by a special duty of non-disclosure (Section 203 of the German Criminal Code, StGB).

In the case of children and young adults, exemption from the duty of non-disclosure is initiated by the legal guardians. Insofar as both parents have legal custody, both must provide their consent. If the affected party is of legal age, they themselves may provide the consent.
