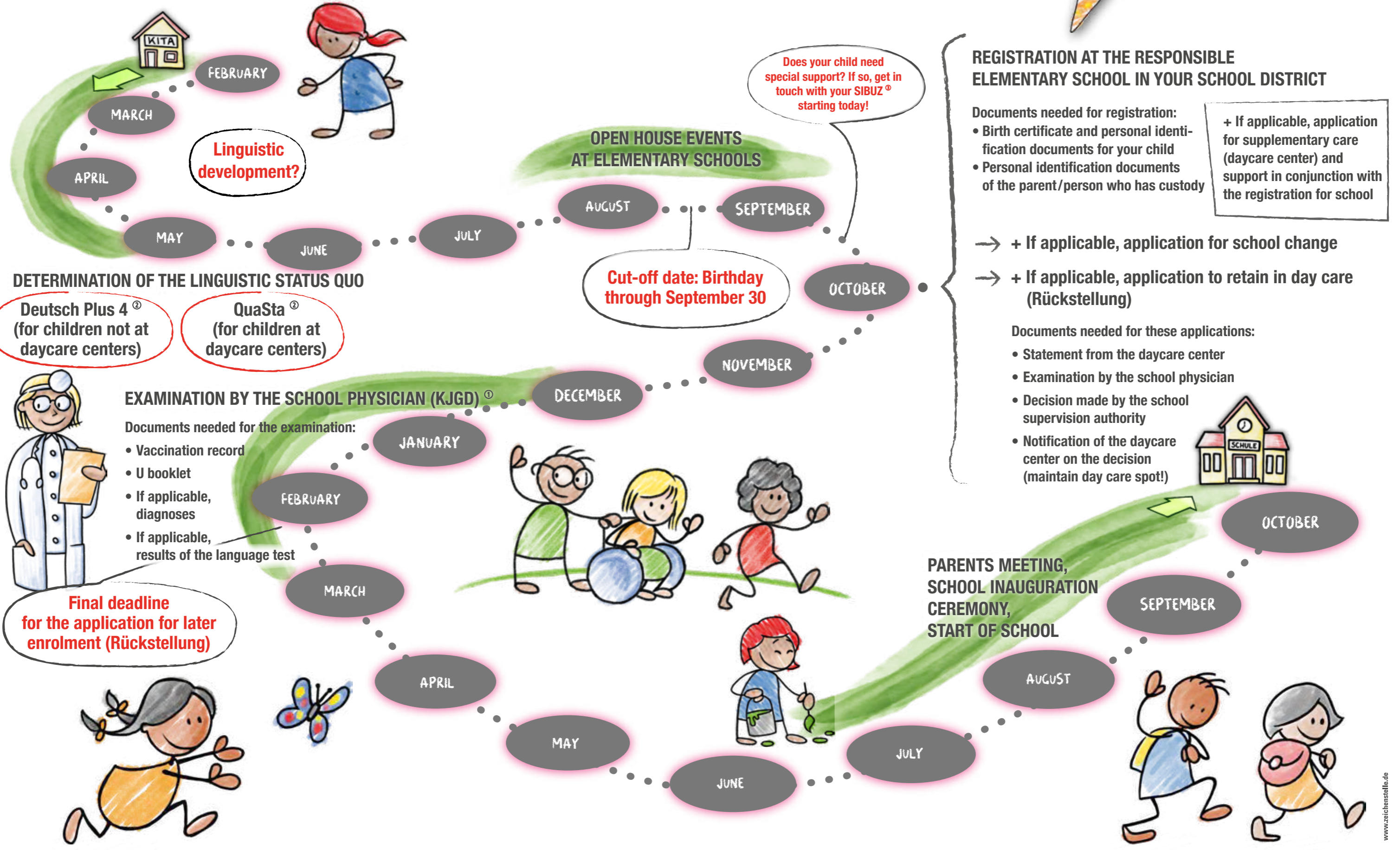

DETERMINATION OF THE LINGUISTIC STATUS QUO

(for children not at daycare centers)

QuaSta[®]
(for children at daycare centers)

EXAMINATION BY THE SCHOOL PHYSICIAN (KJGD)^①

Documents needed for the examination:

- Vaccination record
- U booklet
- If applicable, diagnoses
- If applicable, results of the language test



Final deadline for the application for later enrolment (Rückstellung)

REGISTRATION AT THE RESPONSIBLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN YOUR SCHOOL DISTRICT

- Documents needed for registration:
- Birth certificate and personal identification documents for your child
 - Personal identification documents of the parent/person who has custody

+ If applicable, application for supplementary care (daycare center) and support in conjunction with the registration for school

- + If applicable, application for school change
- + If applicable, application to retain in day care (Rückstellung)

Documents needed for these applications:

- Statement from the daycare center
- Examination by the school physician
- Decision made by the school supervision authority
- Notification of the daycare center on the decision (maintain day care spot!)
