From 5 to 12 March 2027 (excluding 8 March 2027¹), elections will once again be held for the senior citizens' councils in the various districts of Berlin.

What are the district senior citizens' councils?

The district senior citizens' councils champion the interests of the over-60s in their respective districts and act as an intermediary between older residents and the various district authorities.

Are you over 60? Is Berlin your main place of residence?
Are you lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans or intersex?

How about standing as a candidate for your district senior citizens' council?

Give older LGBTI* people in your district a voice! As a member of the senior citizens' council, you can, for example, campaign for the consistent realisation of services for older LGBTI* people and for a provision that better meets their needs.

Would you like to help older LGBTI* people in your district?

Then go and cast your vote during the week from

5 to 12 March 2027 (excluding 8 March 2027¹)!

Or: nominate a candidate.

Anyone can nominate a person – or themselves – as a candidate. It doesn't matter what their nationality is.

Nominations must be submitted by **2 October 2026**.
