Elections for the district
senior citizens' councils 2027

Dear readers,

Between 5 and 12 March 2027, elections will be held in Berlin for the district senior citizens' councils. Are you 60 years of age or older? Then you can vote too!

Who can vote?

Any person aged 60 or over whose main residence is in Berlin. You do not need to have German citizenship.

How do I vote?

By postal vote or at a polling station. Election documents will be sent out to all those entitled to vote.

As well as the election documents, you will also be sent all the relevant information:

- which candidates are standing for election
- when and where the candidates will be giving public presentations to introduce themselves
- when and where you can vote
- which documents you will need to bring with you
- the deadlines for postal votes

You will need to apply for a postal vote until 19 February 2027 until 6:00 pm, and postal voting papers must be received at the district government office until 4 March 2027.

Why should I vote?

District senior citizens' councils – maybe this is the first time you've heard of them.

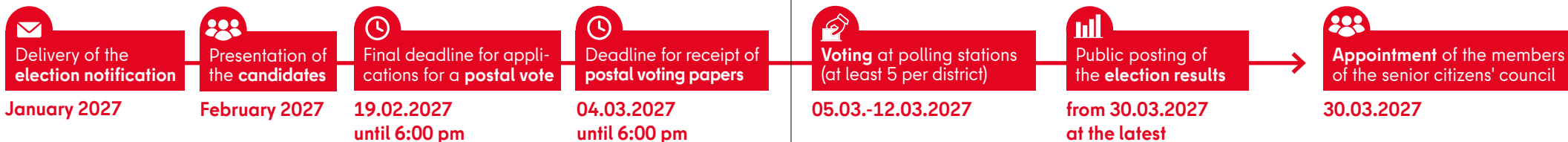
As the voice of Berlin's older population, the senior citizens' councils ensure that the needs and interests of this group are heard during the political decision-making process and taken into account when decisions are made.

The district senior citizens' councils have the opportunity to contribute to policy discussions on all issues of relevance to older people in the committees of the district council.

They also appoint one member and one deputy to the Landesseniorenrat, which in turn advises the Berlin State Parliament and the relevant Senate department on matters relating to senior citizens' policy.

The senior citizens' councils can campaign on a wide range of issues, from improvements such as more benches in local neighbourhoods and traffic lights with a longer green phase to major issues such as protection against the effects of climate change, for example through the development of a heat action plan.

In short: with your vote, you'll be giving a voice and greater weight to the interests of older people.
