

Elise Weinberg was born on 20.11.1852 in Berlin. She married Hermann Gutkind, who was a Jewish merchant and industrialist in Berlin. They had two children: the philosopher Erich Gutkind (9.2.1877 - 26.8.1965). And the architect and urban planner, Erwin Gutkind (20.05.1886 - 7.08.1968). Hermann died before the National Socialists took power. While her sons were able to emigrate, Elise Gutkind stayed in Berlin and was taken care of by her daughter-in-law, Margarete Gutkind. Elise Gutkind was deported to Theresienstadt on 06.08.1942 and died there on 01.09.1942 due to the catastrophic conditions in the concentration camp.
