

**Margarete Jaffé** was born on 26.3.1887 in Berlin. She was a trained graphic designer. She married the architect Erwin Anton Gutkind in 1908. They had three children: Claus (who died of diphtheria at 17 years of age), Gabriele, and Peter. While her husband and daughter emigrated to London, she stayed in Berlin with her younger child, Peter, and looked after both elderly grandmothers. In 1939, a departure was only possible for Peter via the Kindertransport. Margarete Gutkind remained in Germany and was deported on 02.06.1942 to the extermination camp of Sobibor. She was murdered in July 1942.
