Together with Berlin's queer art scene, we're celebrating the diversity of LGBTQIA+ culture on and off stage. Under the motto "Lichtenberg. More Berlin than you think," the district once again showcases its openness, diversity, and vibrant cultural scene.

This year, the festival is being organized jointly for the first time by PINKDOT and the Sonntags-Club—a powerful collaboration for even more visibility, diversity, and community.

Look forward to a thrilling weekend full of queer beats, glittering drag and burlesque performances, empowering sounds, and surprising highlights. Numerous artists will be there, including Transemble, The Murk Prince, Robin Lovelines, and Suli Puschban.

In addition to great music, a diverse program awaits you, featuring comedy, improv theater, and the silent disco "Still Dance." Rachel Intervention and La Zia Jumpy will guide you through the program.

There's also plenty to discover offstage: colorful market stalls, hands-on activities, and entertainment for visitors of all ages.

Two days full of energy: On June 27 from 3 p.m. to 10 p.m. and on June 28 from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m., PINKDOT and the Sonntags-Club will bring queer life, art, and community together under the open sky at Stadtpark Lichtenberg (Parkaue 30 | 10367 Berlin). Where digital creativity meets a vibrant community, a sparkling open-air experience takes shape—a festival for all generations, for queers and allies, for everyone who wants to celebrate, feel, and be seen.

On June 26, the colorful program kicks off with an award-winning film highlight. The open-air cinema will screen the film *Rafika*, directed by Wanuri Kahiu, distributed by Edition Salzgeber Medien. The film begins at dusk. Please bring your own seating.
