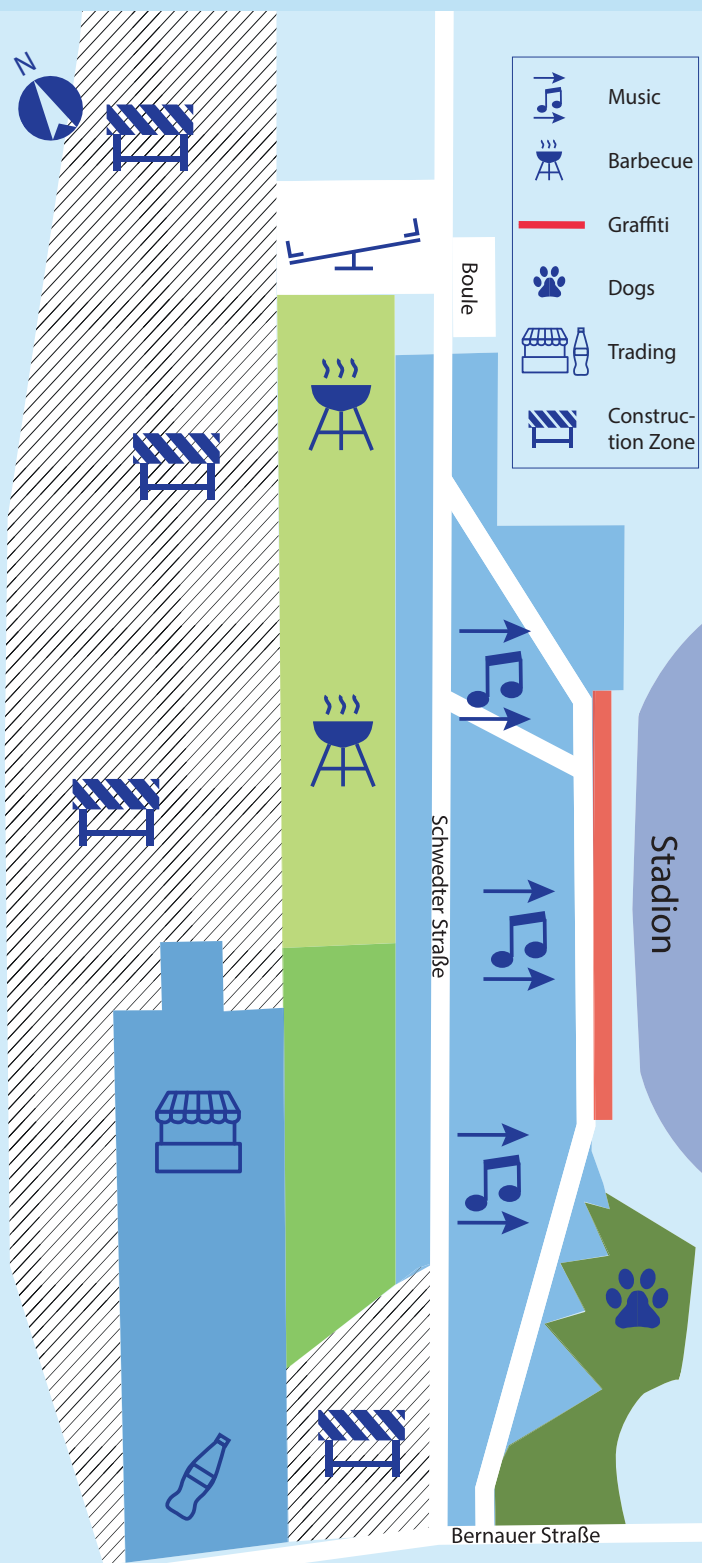

MUSIC

The playing of music is only allowed in the areas marked on the map and provided that no other visitors to the park or residents are disturbed.

Allowed:

- The playing of music to the west of cobbled road (Schwedter Straße) and around 10m west of cobbled road
- Mondays to Thursdays:
11:00 to 19:30
- Fridays to Sundays & Public Holidays :
11:00 to 20:30
- Sound directed towards the slope/stadium

Not allowed:

- Use of generators
- Music directed towards the residential area
- Loud music drowning out quiet music

Commercial events are not allowed under law. A special permit can be applied for on a case-by-case basis at 'Bezirksamt Pankow von Berlin'.

TOILETS

Mauerpark is not a lavatory. Please use the toilet facilities of nearby pubs and restaurants.

BARBECUES

Barbecues are allowed in the areas indicated (see map) all year round between 08:00 and 20:00 (from June to August until 21:00).

- Please remain far enough away from trees and bushes.
- No barbecuing under trees (flying sparks).
- Barbecues must not be used on or near the ground (use stands).
- Barbecuing is only allowed with charcoal, and gas barbecues are not allowed.
- Spent charcoal is to be disposed of in the ash bins provided.
- The lighting and use of open fires (camp fires) is not allowed.
- Entering any part of the park with your vehicle is not allowed, even for loading and unloading.

RUBBISH

Please do not leave any rubbish in Mauerpark and, at the very least, dispose of it in the waste bins along Pflasterstraße. This also includes bottle tops, broken items and cigarette ends. Better still, take your rubbish with you.

GRAFFITI

The 'Hinterlandmauer' by the swings is part of the Berlin Wall that divided Berlin. This makes it a monument. Creative interaction with our history fits in well with the spirit of Mauerpark, which is why graffiti is allowed by the park. Please also remember: Spray cans belong in hazardous waste. So tidy up after spraying.

TRADING

Trading with goods of any nature is not tolerated in Mauerpark. Please use the numerous facilities available in the immediate vicinity of Mauerpark. Illegal trading will be prosecuted.

DOGS

Mauerpark is not a lavatory for dogs. Dog owners are asked to comply with their duty to dispose of dog waste, and also ensure that their dogs do not damage the green areas (no holes are dug) or inconvenience other visitors to the park.

Dogs are allowed to run free in the fenced-off exercise area on Bernauer Straße. Dogs must be kept on leads in the rest of Mauerpark outside the area set aside for dogs.

The taking of dogs into children's play areas is not allowed.
