## Call for applications for the new District Advisory Council for Participation and Integration

We need you! Together we want to achieve more participation in our district. To this end, a new advisory board for participation and integration is to be founded. We are looking for committed people who would like to contribute their perspectives and experiences. Join us on our journey.

**Invitation to (short) application by 10.06.2022**

### What can the Advisory Board for Participation and Integration do?

The advisory board actively promotes the equal participation and inclusion of people with a migration history. As experts with diverse perspectives and migration experiences, the members advise the district administration. In order to represent its perspectives, the advisory board can send members to the public meetings of the district assembly and its committees.

In addition, the district advisory board will exchange ideas with the state advisory board for participation.

### What is the time frame for the involvement in the advisory board?

For the duration of one election period of the district assembly, the advisory board will be an honorary representation for the interests of people with a migration history in the district. The frequency of the meetings and the focus of the work will be determined by the elected advisory board itself. After the election, rules of procedure will be drawn up. It is expected that 3-5 meetings will be held per year. The attendance fee for volunteers is 20 € per meeting. The meetings will be held in German.

### Who can become a member?

The Advisory Board for Participation and Integration offers the opportunity to represent perspectives that have not been (so much) perceived so far. To this end, the advisory board must be diverse: people with disabilities, of different ages, of different genders, etc. should be represented on the board.

Representatives with a migration history should form the majority. German citizenship is not a prerequisite for participation. Persons without a migration history must have

knowledge in questions of participation, integration and equal participation of people with a migration history.

The advisory board for participation and integration is looking for 12 members (especially people with their own migration history), preferably 8 individuals and 4 representatives of an association, organisation or initiative. In addition, one deputy for each member.

Applicants must be at least 16 years old, live and/or work in Tempelhof-Schöneberg and be willing to actively work for the equal participation of people with a migration history.

We are looking forward to receiving your application by 10.06.2022.
