Public Library Guide





Please note!

You want to borrow items from the library?

- Then you will need a library card.

This is how you can get a library card:

- Visit your local public library.
- We will need your identification card, passport, and your register certificate. If you hold a residence permit, we will need this, too.

How much do you have to pay for your library card?

- It is 10€.
- Students and apprentices only pay 5€.

How long is it valid for?

- Your library card is valid for 1 year. You can renew it, once it has expired.

The library card is free for:

- Children, pupils and recipients of social benefits.
- In order to get a reduced library card, we will need proof of your status.

What we offer:

- You can borrow books, board games, CD-Roms for 28 days (4 weeks) and CDs, DVDs and newspapers/ magazines for 14 days (2 weeks).

How many items can you borrow?

- Up to 60 at a time.
Please always check for damages.

When you check something out:

- You will get a paper slip.
- It tells you the return date for your borrowed items.

Can I keep my borrowed items for longer?

Yes, you can!

- You can renew them in the library (bring them along).
- You can do it online. Visit www.voebb.de.
- You can also call us, but we charge 1€ for this service.

If you keep your items past your return date:

- We will charge you! It's called "overdue fee".

How much is it?

- It's 0,25€ per day for each item for adults.
- It's 0,10€ per day for each item for children.

Do you want to borrow an item from another library?

- You decide which library to pick it up from.
- From another librarys:
1€ transportation charge +
1€ service charge.
- You can collect your items within 12 days.

Please let us know immediately, if:

- You have moved.
- You have changed your name.
- You have lost your library card.
