



## Basic information on the coronavirus vaccine

We recommend you get vaccinated to protect yourself and your family!

Where do you get vaccinated?



You live in LAF accommodation

The doctor will come to the accommodation and vaccinate people there.

The vaccine used is BioNTech.

Vaccination is voluntary.



You can decide:

do I want to get vaccinated? Or not?

Vaccination is free of charge.



You don't have to pay to get vaccinated.



Children and young people up to 15 years of age.



Pregnant women.



Anyone with a fever.

Anyone with a vaccine allergy.

An allergy means

that you can't tolerate something.



If you've already had coronavirus.

Then you're still protected now and only need to receive 1 dose of the vaccine later on.

The doctor will say when you'll receive a dose of the vaccine.

Who should not get the vaccine?



## Before getting vaccinated, please tell the doctor:



- if you've already had coronavirus,
- if you've ever felt sick at the doctor's,



- if you've ever been unconscious as a result of an injection,
- if you've had an adverse reaction to a vaccine,



- if you've received another vaccination in the last 2 weeks,



- if you have an allergy.  
An allergy means  
that you can't tolerate something.

## After the vaccination:



**Many people tolerate the vaccine well.**  
**Vaccination is the way back to normal life.**  
For example: visits, language courses, school or work.  
You can go shopping again without taking a test.



**Some people experience mild side effects after vaccination.**  
**They experience pain.**  
**Or they don't feel well.**  
**The side effects shouldn't last long.**



**Are you in pain after being vaccinated?**  
**Do you feel unwell after being vaccinated?**  
**Tell accommodation staff.**



**The staff will ask a doctor.**  
**The doctor will tell you what to do.**
