3. Rights of the data subject (access, rectification, deletion)

Any person subject to the processing of personal data shall have the following rights in accordance with the law:

4. Legal basis for the processing

The time of the deletion of the electronic data or the destruction of the files is based on the administrative documentation legislation requirements.
