




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
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
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
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
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
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Mental health, psychosocial services and psychiatry in Berlin



Dear reader,


The topic of mental health is very much on our minds – triggered by the psychological challenges of the corona pandemic. But what do we mean when we say "mental health"? Good mental health is very important as it is the prerequisite for well-being, your developmental potential, coping with everyday life, interaction with other people as well as quality of life. Mental health is therefore just as important as physical health. There is a reason why the World Health Organisation (WHO) believes that there is "no health without mental health". Mental health also plays an essential role at the societal level. Solidarity and social justice are significantly influenced by the public's mental health.

The preservation and promotion of mental health and the prevention of mental illness are a declared goal of the state of Berlin. The State of Berlin has therefore laid the groundwork for the realisation of this goal through its institutions' and associations' numerous initiatives, measures and projects. In Berlin, mental health is understood as an issue that affects all social spheres and all people.

There are many factors that can influence mental health over a person's lifetime.

In addition to biological and psychological factors, social, socio-economic and cultural conditions also have a significant impact on mental health. And all these factors can

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contribute to a drop in well-being and an increased feeling of stress. If the stress continues and cannot be compensated in other ways, this can lead to mental illness. The mental illness itself often restricts people's social and professional lives and changes their quality of life for the worse. Mental health impairments are widespread in Germany, ranging from mild impairments of general well-being to severe mental disorders.

In recent years, the state of Berlin (along with the districts, welfare organisations, service providers, clinics and specialist departments, independent doctors and psychologists as well as interest groups and relatives) has been putting great effort into providing people suffering psychological stress or mental illness and their friends and family with a differentiated and efficient psychosocial and psychiatric help system.

The help system consists of many different elements.

As part of the locally available psychosocial and psychiatric care system and the health promotion and prevention system, the contact, advice and counselling centres, advice and counselling centres for people addicted to alcohol and medication and the additional income projects all provide easy-to-access services. In addition, the "Berlin crisis service" offers an easy-to-access range of advice and support services, especially in the evenings and at night, for people suffering psychological stress and crises, their families, neighbours and friends.

Another important medical point of contact are the family doctors. In cooperation with psychiatrists and psychological psychotherapists people with mental illnesses receive the necessary advice and treatment here.

The district child and youth psychiatric and the social-psychiatric services offer information and advice for those affected by mental illness, their families or their social environment. The multi-professional teams closely coordinate with the help system by referring people to one of Berlin's wide range of services and helping with organisation. A variety of employment offers and services in the area of assisted living as well as day care centres are provided in the districts, in particular for people whose mental illness means they are restricted in their social participation. The district's psychiatry and addiction help coordinators are important contact points.

The psychiatric clinics and units are for seriously ill people requiring inpatient treatment. At the same time, more and more clinics are offering an alternative to traditional inpatient treatment: Depending on disease symptoms, treatment may be carried out at home or in an outpatient clinic instead.

All these services are part of what is called regional mandatory care ("regionalisierte Pflichtversorgung"). They are available to all citizens of Berlin depending on the individual support they need.

This brochure provides you an overview of the help and support services available in the state of Berlin. The first part is about the individual segments of Berlin's differentiated care system. The second part of the brochure introduces the facilities and services for advice and counselling, support, care, treatment, nursing care and emergency care for people with a mental illness in the individual districts, i.e., close to where people live.

This brochure does not list all the independent doctors, psychotherapists and other services and facilities that deal with the mental health of the people of Berlin and is not intended to replace the districts' health guides. This brochure is intended to give an overview of the central points of contact of the psychosocial and psychiatric care system and serve as guidance.

However, while such a differentiated care system can never be perfect, it can strive to keep improving. It is therefore important that you provide positive as well as critical feedback. The independent complaints and information centre for psychiatry can be a useful point of contact in this regard.

As the state representative for psychiatry, the mental health of the citizens of Berlin is a particular concern of mine. There is still a stigma attached to mental illness. Many people find it difficult to talk about psychological stress or mental illness, even though it is a normal part of our life. Psychological stress or mental illness can be dealt with more effectively if you talk about it with other people. The psychosocial and psychiatric services in the state of Berlin provide information, advise and counselling, and support and give you the opportunity to talk. If you need advice, do get in touch with one of the services listed in this brochure.



Treatment, advice and counselling, crisis support

Outpatient treatment for adults

The treatment of mental illness is covered by the statutory health insurance. Treatment is provided by independent doctors specialising in neurology, psychiatry and psychotherapy, psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy, and by independent medical and psychological psychotherapists and family doctors.

The Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians of Berlin has set up an online search platform at www.kvberlin.de where you can find a doctor or psychotherapist near you. You can also call the health guide service ("Gesundheitslotsendienst"):



For people with a mental illness who do not wish to regularly see an independent doctor for treatment or are unable to do so can instead visit an institute outpatient clinic, which can be found in all hospitals with a psychiatric unit. These clinics provide outpatient advance and/or follow-up care, which allows treatment at a hospital to continue uninterrupted.

Outpatient treatment for children and adolescents

The many different ways in which mental disorders and illnesses in childhood and adolescence manifest and progress means that the child's/adolescent's physical, developmental-psychological and social aspects need to be looked at. Close cooperation between the attending specialists (e.g. in child and youth psychiatry and psychotherapy) and therapists (psychological psychotherapists, child and adolescent psychotherapists)

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and the child and adolescent welfare services and the school sector is often indispensable to ensure the best possible treatment of young people and their families.

Independent doctors for child and youth psychiatry and psychotherapists cannot always be found close to where you live. Information on this is provided by the Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians of Berlin; their phone number can be found in the previous section under "Outpatient treatment for adults".

Lists of independent doctors, for adults as well as for children and adolescents, can also be found on the websites of the Association of Statutory Health Insurance Physicians of Berlin (www.kvberlin.de), Berlin's medical association (www.aerztekammer-berlin.de) and Berlin's association of psychotherapists (www.psychotherapeutenkammer-berlin.de).

Inpatient treatment for adults


In particularly severe cases or acute emergencies, people with a mental illness or addiction are treated as inpatients in the specialist departments for psychiatry and psychotherapy of hospitals. There is at least one such department at a hospital or a psychiatric hospital in every district in Berlin. These hospitals are not far away, the hospital is known, and the mental illness is treated under the same conditions as a physical one. You can find the hospital responsible for your district in this brochure under "Contacts and addresses".

Hospitals are required to admit people in need of treatment. This applies to patients (adults, children and adolescents) who live in the district and to patients who happen to be in the district or are found there.

Psychosomatic medicine

The field of psychosomatic medicine and psychotherapy encompasses the identification, somatotherapeutic, psychosomatic-medical and psychotherapeutic treatment, prevention and rehabilitation of diseases and conditions which are in significantly caused by

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psychosocial and psychosomatic factors, including the resulting physical-mental interactions.

Berlin's population is growing and people suffering from mental and psychosomatic illnesses are increasingly willing to make active use of help services; this makes it necessary to adapt clinical capacity in line with demand as well as to promote innovative care models with inter-sectoral links and ensure cooperation between care providers. Psychosomatic medicine is mainly about the treatment of people with several and often chronic diseases. This in particular applies to people with primary somatic illnesses with significant accompanying psychological symptoms, i.e., somatopsychiatric symptoms.


The care landscape in Berlin is particularly being adjusted by expanding outpatient clinic capacities and promoting cooperation with existing supraregional psychosomatic care services while consistently implementing the structural principle of regional mandatory care. This reflects the community psychiatric approach such that networking structures in the district (including with the outpatient care system, social psychiatric services and providers of integration aid) can be utilised and patients can continue to be cared for close to where they live if necessary following full or partial inpatient treatment.

Outpatient clinics with a psychosomatic focus primarily serve the further treatment or co-treatment of somatic symptoms with significant psychological factors regarding aetiology, aggravation or symptom perception as well as the avoidance or shortening of inpatient psychosomatic treatments.

Providing more semi-residential treatment prevents hospitalisation and keeps people in touch with their living environment, which they will need to be able to manage again after discharge from hospital. This allows people to practice and implement what they have learned in their familiar living environment.

Outpatient clinics

Every hospital with a psychiatric unit has at least one outpatient clinic. On weekdays it offers patients the possibility of partial inpatient treatment after hospital treatment or if hospital treatment is not necessary and pure outpatient treatment is not enough. In the evenings, at night and at the weekends, patients live in their normal surroundings. This either makes the transition from hospital to home easier or often even renders a hospital stay unnecessary.



Hospital treatment of children and adolescents

In particularly severe cases or acute emergencies, children and adolescents with a mental illness or addiction are treated as inpatients in the specialist departments for child and youth psychiatry and psychotherapy of hospitals.

There are six care regions for child and youth psychiatry and psychotherapy in Berlin. One care region comprises two neighbouring districts. In addition, each region has an institute outpatient clinic.

Inpatient care is mainly used for the diagnosis and treatment of psychiatric disorders in children and adolescents. This form of treatment should only be provided once all other possible treatments have been exhausted. Treatment in an outpatient clinic has the advantage that the children and adolescents can continue living with their families and in their normal social environment.


Involuntary commitment

A special form of clinical psychiatry is hospitalisation as part of the "Maßregelvollzug - Krankenhausbetrieb des Landes (KMV)" rules. If a person commits a serious criminal offence and is not (Section 20 of the StGB) or only partially (Section 21 of the StGB) culpable due to a mental illness, the court will order them to be sectioned in a psychiatric hospital (Section 63 of the StGB). This also generally applies to substance abuse and placement in a detoxification facility (Section 64 of the StGB). These hospitalisations ordered by the court are not part of the regional mental health care system.

The KMV has two sites (on the grounds of the former Karl-Bonhoeffer psychiatric clinic in Berlin-Reinickendorf and on the grounds of the Medical Area II Buch in the Berlin-Pankow district) and is divided into seven units with 541 beds approved by the regulatory authorities. Plans are in place to extend the clinic on the site of the former Karl-Bonhoeffer psychiatric clinic.

Involuntary commitment into a hospital (Maßregelvollzug) is aimed to safeguard public safety. But above all, it is designed to enable patients to integrate into the community through treatment and care.

Social psychiatric services

The social psychiatric services are the departments of the districts' departments of health in all districts of Berlin. Some districts have several departments to make the service more accessible. The staff (including psychiatrists and neurologists, social workers and psychologists) offer help and support for adults with a mental illness, addiction or mental disability.

Who are the social psychiatric services for?

For adults

- with mental illnesses (such as depression, psychosis, anxiety, OCD),
- in crisis situations,
- for elderly people who are confused and cannot manage on their own without help,
- for people with a mental disability,
- for people addicted to alcohol, drugs and medication and for people with other addictions,
- for family members, neighbours and friends of people with a mental illness, confused people, people with a mental disability or addicted people.

Advice, referrals and crisis intervention are offered in the departments or during home visits for the affected people themselves, their family members and the people in their social environment in the following cases

- Personal and material difficulties,
- Arranging home (nursing) care,
- Integration assistance measures,
- Clarification of questions regarding legal care,
- Referral to outpatient and inpatient care,

- Questions about therapy options and crisis intervention, including hospitalisation under the mental health act ("Gesetz für psychisch Kranke").

The social psychiatric service works closely with other facilities in the district and beyond and refers people to outpatient and inpatient help services.

The staff of the social psychiatric service can be reached from Monday to Friday from 8 am to 4 pm. During this time, the social psychiatric service is also responsible for emergency psychiatric care in the district. The primary goal is to exhaust all help options to avoid enforcement measures. In the event of acute danger to self or others, the doctor makes a decision on how to proceed in accordance with the mental health act.

Child and youth psychiatry services

The child and youth psychiatry services are advice and counselling centres affiliated with the district offices of the Department of Health and sometimes with the Department of Youth.


They offer

- parents worried about the emotional, mental, physical and social development of their children
- adolescents who have difficulties in dealing with their parents, teachers or peers, have learning or performance difficulties or problems with drugs
- families with parenting problems or conflicts they are unable to resolve by themselves

the following services:

- medical and psychological diagnostics and advice
- Crisis intervention
- Advice and counselling for parents and families
- Recommendation, referral, initiation and professional monitoring of help from the various funding agencies




- Advice on all measures of integration assistance in close cooperation with the youth welfare facilities and schools
- Expert opinions for public authorities and agencies
- Cooperation with all caregivers in the different areas of the children's lives in agreement with the parents.

In case of problems and difficulties, such as

- Physical, mental and social development (e.g. motor skills, perception, language, concentration, intelligence and relationships)
- Educational development (e.g. dyslexia or dyscalculia, reluctance to go to school, refusal to go to school, fear of exams and failure)
- Attention and hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)
- Social behavioural problems (e.g. aggression, lying, stealing, social isolation)
- Behavioural problems with physical disorders (e.g. eating disorders, bed wetting)
- Emotional disorders (e.g. anxiety, withdrawal, depression, attachment disorders)
- Psychosomatic disorders (e.g. nausea, abdominal pain and headaches)
- Neurotic disorders (e.g. OCD)
- Psychotic disorders
- Violence, abuse, addiction
- Educational issues (e.g. setting boundaries)
- Detachment problems and crises of adolescence
- Communication and relationship problems in the family
- Stresses and crises in the family (e.g. separation, divorce, deaths, chronic illnesses)
- Problems related to cultural origin and integration

parents, adolescents and families can contact the child and youth psychiatry service. In special cases, observations and consultations are carried out in children's daycare centre and schools as well as home visits.

Berlin crisis service

The Berlin crisis service offers help and support for people in emotional distress and psychiatric crisis situations. People have different reasons for contacting the crisis service: mental illness, suicidal tendency, traumatic experiences, depression, anxiety and panic, mental disability, separation and loss, addiction, family and relationships conflicts and much more.


The Berlin crisis service also offers support for people in the living environment of an affected person, such as partners, relatives, friends, colleagues or neighbours. Often they are so worried that they need information and advice, or they are so stressed that they themselves need help.

The Berlin crisis service also provides support to professional help facilities and the general emergency services. Doctors, therapists and the staff at social institutions as well as the police and fire service can contact the crisis service at any time, especially in emergencies.

The Berlin crisis service can be reached around the clock, 365 days a year.

There are 9 regional counselling centres in Berlin; they are open daily from 4 pm to midnight (their addresses and telephone numbers are listed in this brochure under the relevant district or online at www.berliner-krisendienst.de). During this time, people can get help over the phone or directly in one of the advice and counselling centres. There is no need to book an appointment, help is provided free of charge and, on request, anonymously. In particularly urgent and acute situations, the staff of the Berlin crisis service travel to the scene of the emergency. Psychiatrists are on call who can also be called in quickly.

Outside its main opening hours, the Berlin crisis service offers a transregional emergency service providing help and support at night and during the day (midnight to 4 pm). Their main consultation office is in the Mitte region (Große Hamburger Str. 5, 10115 Berlin-Mitte). People seeking help can reach the on-call service via any of the telephone number of the Berlin crisis service (automatic call forwarding after midnight). During the week (8 am to 4 pm) the service only provides information and referrals over the phone.



Contact, and advice and counselling centres

Contact, and advice and counselling centres (KBS) are open to all mentally ill people, their families and interested persons. The services offered by the KBS range from finding contacts, organising leisure activities, participation in group activities to individual counselling sessions. Many KBS centres offer special services and events such as group trips, outings, cultural and sports activities, musical events or a warm lunch. They also make their premises available to self-help groups, which offer support without professional guidance.

Various services such as the contact, and advice and counselling centres, additional income, day care centres and other forms of care are often found in the day centres. This gives visitors flexibility because they can take advantage of the services based on their current circumstances. KBS visitors can, for example, visit a day care centre for support or give the additional income service a try. And day care centre and additional income service visitors can also use the services of the contact, advice and counselling centres.

Advice and counselling centres for people addicted to alcohol and medication


When alcohol and medication becomes a problem, advice and counselling centres offer professional help to people addicted to alcohol and medication. In addition to providing help to the people affected, they also offer support to others, such as family members, partners, friends or work colleagues.

The advice and counselling centres offer addiction counselling and care as well as outpatient therapy (individual and group therapy). They refer people to withdrawal treatments and self-help groups, provide assistance for social and practical life situations and offer information about counselling services at other institutions, such as debt counselling centres and educational and family counselling centres. Every district of Berlin has advice and counselling centres for people addicted to alcohol and medication. Some of these centres are integrated advice and counselling centres, which also offer advice for people addicted to illegal substances.

Living and everyday life

People are referred to the services of assisted living and the day care centres in cooperation with the "psychiatry/addiction steering committee" of the respective district.

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The steering committees determine what type of help people need and suggest an appropriate measure on this basis. This may be care in a therapeutic residential community, one-to-one care in a person's own home, care in a day care centre, but also particularly intensive care in a transitional home. A wide range of help options is available. Individual care requests are taken into account whenever possible, such as a mixed-sex or female- or male-only residential community.

As a rule, the service providers, the funding agency ("TeilhabeFachdienst"), the hospital sector, the social psychiatric service, the psychiatry coordination service and other participants (e.g. from the care service) as well as the person seeking help themselves, if they so wish, work together in the psychiatry steering committee.

The decision on the measure to be approved is made by the funding agency of the responsible district office ("TeilhabeFachdienst").

You can obtain more information about the services available in your district and how they work from the psychiatric coordination service, the social psychiatric service or the "TeilhabeFachdienst" agency of your district office.

Assisted living

Assisted living helps people with a mental illness or addiction cope with the demands of everyday life, organise their day, find contacts and find employment, work and training. The objective of the service, how it is provided and to what extent depend on the individual needs of the person being cared for. They can either be cared for in their own home or in a residential community. There is also the possibility of care in special housing (homes and transitional homes), but this is not available in all districts of Berlin.

In addition to the assisted living facilities provided in each of the 12 Berlin districts as part of the regional mandatory care, there are individual transregional services in the state of Berlin. This includes, for example, assisted living for mentally ill gay men, for suicidal mentally ill young adults, for mentally ill drug addicts and for addicted women.

On 1 July 2010, the act on strengthening self-determination and participation and on the protection of people in jointly assisted living arrangements ("WohnTeilhabeGesetz" (WTG)) came into force. This successor legislation to the federal home act ("BundesheimGesetz") for the first time enshrines in law for their to be shared accommodation (WG) for people with care needs and disabled people who make use of care and support services. These shared accommodation communities could thus be inspected on an ad hoc basis in order



to ensure the necessary protection of the residents if required. The WTG act has been revised and most recently amended on 4 May 2021 (GVBL. No. 35 p. 417).

Day care centres

The day care centres care for mentally ill and addicted people during the day outside their own homes. Like with assisted living, they provide help in organising the day, finding contacts, and promoting employment, work and training. The centres also offer guided group activities and employment offers.



Work, employment and training

Work is of central importance for every person's life. This is just as true for people with severe mental illness. Even after retirement due to mental illness, the question of employment remains, because not many people can, want or should be treated and cared for all day.


Work is not to be understood solely as a job within the general labour market, but as a wide variety of opportunities for employment. This includes voluntary work, occupational day care, work and occupational therapy, hourly employment as part of the additional income service, employment in a workshop, participation in measures of the employment office, school and training, employment in an integration company, etc. The industry guide "social companies of Berlin ("Soziale Unternehmen Berlin") was created specifically for people with mental illness, which describes the various rehabilitation, integration and additional income options that are available. Information about this can also be found on this website: www.soziale-unternehmen-berlin.de.

There are also vocational training opportunities adapted to the needs of mentally disabled young adults. The training takes place in vocational workshops (in Berlin at the [BBW-RKI](#)). Your local employment agency will answer questions about funding and registration.

Additional income

One possibility of employment in regional psychiatric care is provided by the additional income service, which is partly publicly funded in Berlin.

The additional income service primarily offers chronically mentally ill people easy access to employment or work, even if they are not fit for employment within the meaning of SGB II. Users of the service can try out a number of different types of activity with flexible working hours. The offers of the additional income service take into account the capabilities of chronically mentally ill people and are specifically set up with them in mind. A small expense allowance is paid.



Workshops for disabled people

The services offered by workshops for disabled people (WfbM) are aimed at people with disabilities who cannot (yet) work in the general labour market but who are able to perform a certain level of work and thus meet the admission requirements. The WfbM must accept all people with disabilities, irrespective of the type and severity of their disability.

An introductory phase, during which it is to be determined whether the WfbM is the suitable institution, is generally followed by a two-year phase for the promotion of participation in the world of work in the vocational training area of the WfbM. For people with disabilities who cannot join the general labour market or a vocational training or qualification course following these measures, the workshops offer a wide range of jobs which take account of people's different capabilities, development opportunities, aptitudes and inclinations as much as possible. The vocational training and workplace services also include positions on the general labour market.

The state of Berlin has 17 workshop providers currently offering more than 8,000 workshop places in numerous facilities spread throughout the city. In addition to four workshop providers who specialise in supporting people with mental disabilities, people with mental disabilities are also accepted by all other workshop providers.

Information on vocational integration in workshops for disabled people is provided by the rehabilitation agencies, in particular the social welfare agencies (district offices), the Federal Employment Agency (employment agencies) and pension insurance companies. Information can also of course be obtained from all the workshop providers. Inclusion companies


Inclusion companies offer jobs for people with disabilities who would otherwise find it particularly difficult to integrate into the general labour market due to the nature and severity of their disability. This includes in particular people with mental or psychological disabilities or with severe physical disabilities, sensory impairment or multiple disabilities. People who have completed workshops for people with disabilities and special needs schools are also part of the target group of integration projects.

Unlike other companies in the general labour market, inclusive companies offer their severely disabled employees work-accompanying support, which is provided by trained

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social education workers. For these companies, making a profit is not the only factor that determines their business activities. Their business focus is on the employment of severely disabled people and the promotion of their participation in the world of work and society.

The state of Berlin has about 40 inclusive companies and more than 1,500 employees are active in service sectors such as gardening and landscaping, building cleaning, painting, catering, wholemeal bakery and party services. Support for family members

When a family member is mentally ill, this is often also a great challenge for their relatives. Information, advice and support is available for family members from the "Angehörigen psychisch Kranker - Landesverband Berlin e.V." association.

Self-help

Self-help has become an integral part of Berlin's health and social services, where people can find information and support from other people affected by mental illness. Many self-help groups meet in the contact, advice and counselling centres for mentally ill people, in the addiction advice and counselling centres or the self-help contact points, which can be found in every district.

If you are looking for a self-help group for your condition or would like to start one yourself, you can contact one of these centres.

You can find the addresses of contact, advice and counselling centres for mentally ill people and for addiction advice and counselling centres in this brochure under "Contacts and addresses". You can also find the self-help contact point in your area online at www.sekis.de.

Complaints offices

The services of the complaints offices are aimed at citizens suffering from mental disorders and impairments and their families. The complaints offices accept suggestions and complaints related to medical or other outpatient treatment/therapy or psychosocial care in the non-clinical sector. They advise (it is not legal advice!) and support the complainant in exercising their rights. The complaints offices are independent bodies, but work together with the psychiatric and psychosocial care institutions, aiming to find amicable solutions that suit all parties involved.

Several of Berlin's districts have a complaints office, such as Lichtenberg, Reinickendorf, Spandau and Tempelhof-Schöneberg.

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In addition, the complaints and Information office for psychiatry in Berlin ("Beschwerde- und Informationsstelle Psychiatrie in Berlin (BIP)") is a Berlin-wide and independent office. In cooperation with the other complaints offices it accepts complaints from users, family members and staff and also offers other services such as advice and counselling in different languages.



Planning, cooperation, networking

State advisory committee for mental health ("Landessbeirat für psychische Gesundheit")


The member of the Senate responsible for health appoints a state advisory committee for mental health consisting of professionals who offer advice on all matters relating to the provision of appropriate care for people with mental illness. The legal basis for the appointment and activity of the psychiatric advisory committee in the state of Berlin is the Berlin law on assistance and protective measures in the case of mental illness ("Gesetz über Hilfen und Schutzmaßnahmen bei psychischen Krankheiten").

District advisory committees for mental health

Similar to the state advisory committee for mental health, there is an advisory committee for mental health consisting of professionals in the districts; the committee advises the responsible district councillor for health on all questions regarding the needs-oriented care for mentally ill people. The legal basis for the appointment and activity of the psychiatric advisory committee is the Berlin law on public health service ("Gesetz über den öffentlichen Gesundheitsdienst").

Psychiatric coordination

With the increased responsibility of the districts in providing help for mentally ill people, the need for coordination and management of the district help system has also increased. The psychiatric coordinators which can be found in all districts of Berlin play a central role here. They are responsible for the planning, management and coordination of the community psychiatric care services in close cooperation with the care service providers. They also act as contact persons for those affected, their families and the staff of the services and institutions on questions of psychiatric treatment, care and nursing. The qualitative development of the psychiatric care system and bringing it in line with new forms of treatment or care and legal conditions are among the tasks of psychiatric coordination.



Addiction and drug help coordination

In addition to the psychiatric coordination, all districts of Berlin also have addiction help coordinators and/or addiction officers. The focus of their tasks and function varies from district to district. The addiction help coordination points mainly deal with needs assessment, the development and coordination of services within the addiction help system and the provision of expert advice and information to professionals and, in some cases, to affected citizens. They are available as points of contact for all services and facilities dealing with drug and addiction problems in a district; they are listed in this brochure under "Contacts and addresses".

Psychosocial working group

The psychosocial working group (PSAG) is a meeting place for psychiatric professionals from institutions, public authorities, associations, as well as affected persons and relatives of mentally ill people in a district, where they can exchange views on issues relating to care in the district. The PSAG works towards cooperation between all those involved in the care of mentally ill people and must be consulted by the responsible authorities when it comes to their duty of community-based psychiatric care.

Associations


In response to the higher demands on the quality of care, psychiatric associations have been set up in some districts in recent years. The associations bring together service providers and institutions of a region/district join forces in order to improve the care of mentally ill and/or addicted people by implementing existing services and making more effective use of them.

The binding integration of help services enables, for example, a smoother transfer of people from hospital to the outpatient sector (family doctors). It is usually easier to ensure the continuous treatment, care and nursing of the people affected within an association. This can avoid repeated hospital stays or the premature admission of patients into a home. Associations make it easier to identify and eliminate deficiencies and bottlenecks in supply. Joint training and further education programmes can help safeguard the quality of the work of the associations.

The following types of association exist in Berlin:

– Community psychiatric association

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
– Geriatric and gerontopsychiatric associations

– Addiction and drug associations

In the community psychiatric association, under the leadership of the district, the providers of facilities and services for psychiatric care, the service providers, those affected and their families come together with the aim of establishing and developing the community psychiatric care network in a binding manner and oriented towards the individual case. In Berlin, this form of association was developed and tested for the first time in the Reinickendorf district.

The geriatric-gerontopsychiatric association is a network of geriatric care and psychiatric facilities in a care region, which provides elderly people with physical and mental disabilities with the care that meets their individual needs. These associations can be found in all districts.

The addiction association is a binding cooperation of the bodies and institutions in a district that are active in the field of addiction prevention and addiction help. Their aim is to safeguard and improve the quality of life of people at risk of addiction and people suffering from addiction. Addiction associations do not yet exist in all districts.



Points of contact with other help services

Child and youth welfare

Child and youth welfare comprises a multitude of historically grown tasks and institutions; they are there, in addition to family and school, to support, promote (e.g. through leisure, educational and advice and counselling offers) and help young people (e.g. in stress, emergency and crisis situations) as they grow up through educational measures. The youth welfare services are responsible for child welfare and are therefore obliged to intervene when children's and young people's circumstances put them at risk (child protection: www.berlin.de/kinderschutz). The remit of the child and youth welfare services are described in Social Code VIII (child and youth welfare act).

The target groups are

- Children under the age of 14,
- Adolescents between the ages of 14 and 18 and
- young adults between the ages of 18 and 27.


Cooperation between child and youth psychiatry and psychotherapy and child and adolescent welfare services is particularly important when young people have medical problems and require specialist treatment. But this also applies the other way around, if a child needs social-educational help and support following treatment in a child and youth psychiatric clinic. Another frequent partner in this context is the school. The youth welfare office of the district decides together with the parties involved what is best for the individual child or young person in their respective situation.

Elderly people in need of care

All parts of a district's mental health care network are also open to older people with mental illness. In the case of people in need of long-term care who are entitled to benefits

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


under the long-term care insurance act ("Pflegeversicherungsgesetz"), which help offer is most likely to meet the individual's needs should be decided on a case-by-case basis.

The service providers of the geriatric care system can provide outpatient care (care services, assisted living), semi-residential care (day care, short-term care) or inpatient care (homes). Furthermore, since the introduction of the supplementary care services act (PflEG) in 2002, additional advice, counselling and care services are being provided for persons in need of care and who are significantly restricted in their everyday lives (i.e. people with dementia, mentally ill and mentally disabled people) through outpatient care services or easy-to-access care services. The newly established care support bases are free advice and counselling centres for people with care needs, for people at risk of needing care, for disabled people and for their families. They provide information on long-term care insurance benefits, health insurance and the selection and use of other federal or state social benefits and types of assistance. The care support bases in Berlin can be found at: www.pflegestuetzpunkteberlin.de.

More information is available online at www.berlin.de/pflege or from the long-term care insurance funds. This wide range of advice, counselling and care services offered by the geriatric and psychiatric care services is also available to those affected and their relatives in crisis situations. Each district has a geriatric-gerontopsychiatric association, which adapts help to the needs of individuals and provides help for people in need of care with mental impairments and their families. The main aim of this cooperation is to avoid repeated hospital stays and premature home admissions. Information about the services available for people with gerontopsychiatric problems is available from the district psychiatric coordinators and from the social services department responsible for geriatric care planning in each district.

The Senate Administration for Health, Care and Equality and the Senate Administration for Integration, Employment and Social Affairs provide information on the care system for elderly people and people with care needs. The telephone number for both public authorities is: (030) 9028-0.



Help for women who have experienced violence

Violence is one of the greatest health risks for women. According to a study carried out by the University of Osnabrück, for example, 22% of all women (i.e. one in every five women who come into contact with the health care system) have suffered gender-based violence in a form that has consequences for her health. Studies show that experiences of violence can have serious consequences for women's mental health.

Depending on their primary need for help, women have access to various anti-violence facilities (especially shelters and residential facilities) and psychiatric help services. The addresses and telephone numbers as well as more information on anti-violence facilities can be found on the website of the Senate Administration for Health, Care and Equality (www.berlin.de/sen/frauen/keine-gewalt/). First points of contact can also be found in this brochure under the heading "Crisis and emergency numbers for adults".


Addiction and drug help

A wide range of help services is available for people with addictions. Easy-to-access contact points offer survival help anyone can make use of; for people with addictions they can provide the motivation to take the first step out of the addiction in addition to direct care services. This also includes outreach work in the street. Advice and counselling centres provide information, advice and support for addicts and refer them to other services. Outpatient and inpatient treatment facilities offer longer-term withdrawal treatments. The offers for substitution patients and the measures following therapy, such as assisted living and training and employment offers, complement the range of help services.

The ultimate goal is for every person who wants to do something about their substance abuse and/or addiction to get the help they need.

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


Help for the homeless

The contact point if you are homeless is the social welfare office in the district in which you were registered to live most recently. There you will receive help and advice.

You should seek advice at the first sign that you may lose your home. Homelessness can very often be prevented if existing rights and opportunities are taken advantage of at an early stage.

If additional help is needed due to mental illness or addiction, the social psychiatric services of the districts are available as points of contact.
