The protection of Jewish life and culture is very important to the Berlin Police. Antisemitic attacks against Jews or those considered Jewish are always directed against the values of free, democratic and open societies. As part of hate crime and Group-Focused Enmity, Antisemitism threatens peaceful coexistence and the stability of society. The fight against antisemitism is a challenge and a task for society as a whole. Law enforcement authorities have a special responsibility in this regard, because they are in charge of repressing, preventing and averting dangers.

Duties and Responsibilities

The duties and responsibilities of the Berlin Police Delegated Officer for Antisemitism include:

- Central contact person for the subject matter, both internally and externally
- Press and public relations
- Active networking for focused expertise and professional exchange on police preventive and repressive measures, on causes, manifestations, effects and the possibilities of prosecution of Antisemitism
- Initiation and support of basic and further training in the field of Antisemitism
- Raising awareness of Antisemitism in the Berlin Police
