

Information sheet for travelers from abroad

Dear travelers, welcome to Berlin! Together, our important task is to prevent SARS-CoV-2 from continuing to spread unnoticed.

This information sheet is relevant for three different groups:

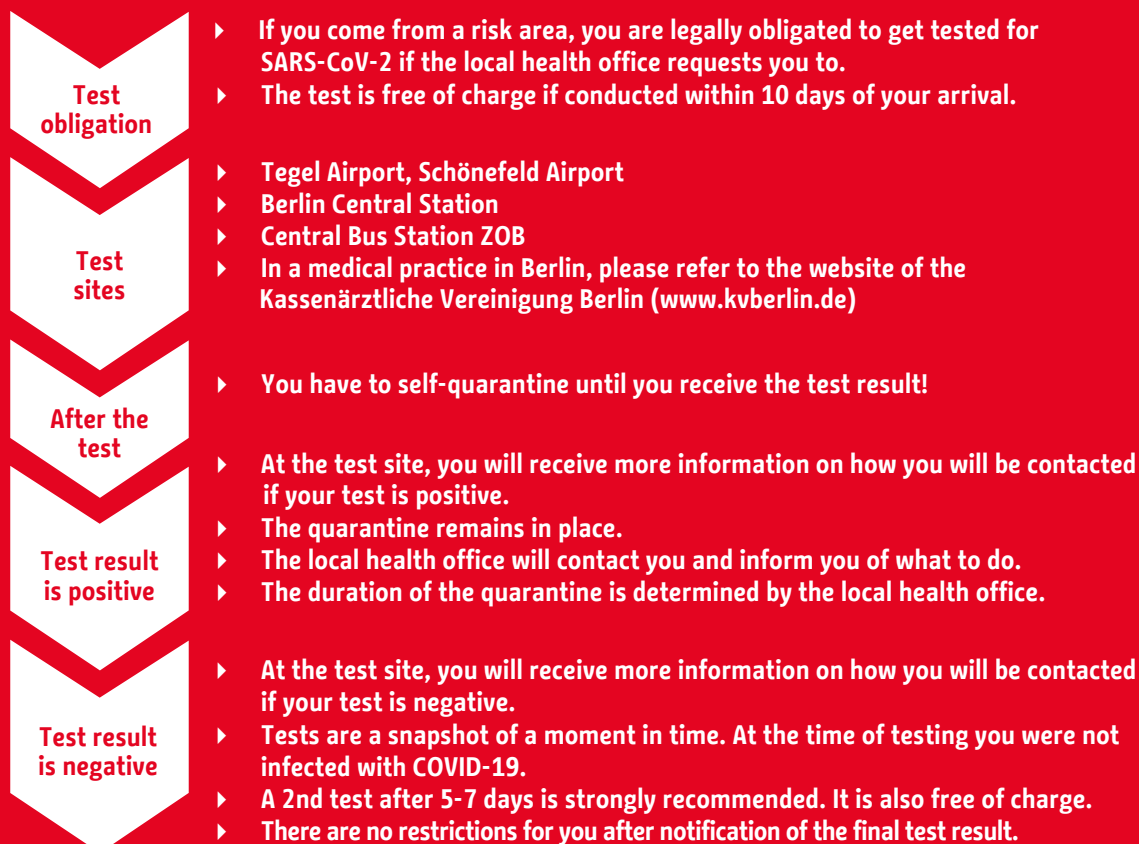
- ▶ Travelers from risk areas
- ▶ Travelers from other areas
- ▶ Travelers showing symptoms indicating they might be infected with SARS-CoV-2

Travelers from risk areas with an elevated number of SARS-CoV-2 infections:

If you have been in a risk area during the 14-day period before entering Berlin, you are legally obligated to go home immediately and remain in self-quarantine for 14 days. Additionally, since August 08, you are legally obliged to get tested for SARS-CoV-2 if requested by the local health office (Gesundheitsamt des Bezirks), and to inform the local health office about the test result.

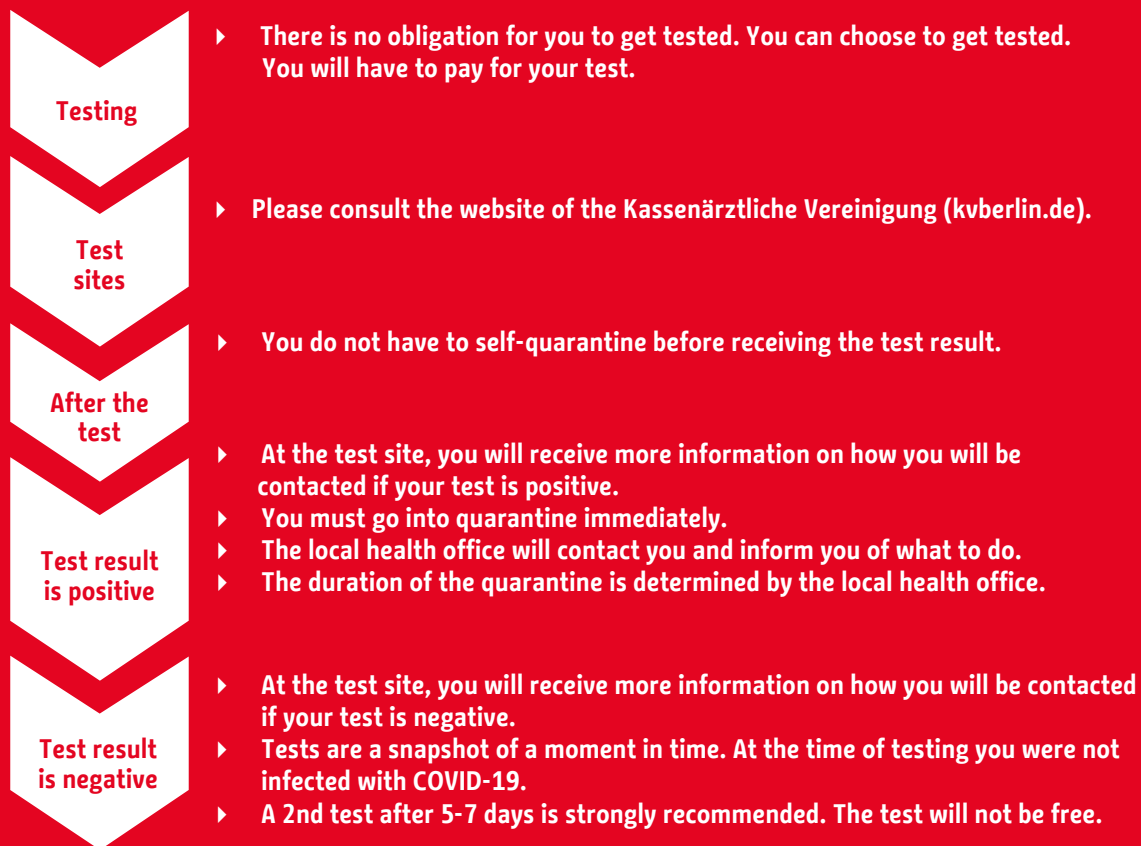
